Greeting, Singing, and Volunteering at Toyooka Junior High School

Toyooka is a traditional school in Toyohashi city. The city is located in the Easter Mikawa area of Aichi Prefecture. Our school is located in a growing area of Toyohashi city. Due to this growth and the increase in student population we have separated into different schools. Since population has been growing new apartment blocks have been built and relationships between people have become weaker than in the past. At school there are many foreign students, some of these students have a difficulty adjusting to the school because of the differences in language, culture, life style, and relationship values.

We want students to think that it is important to connect with others, society, have good judgment, be considerate, and behave responsibility with the community in mind. To make this possible we have decided to implement Educational for Sustainable Development or (ESD). ESD will give the students a scene of pride in the region, understand the people who live here, and better serve society

At first the faculty of our school had to study ESD impact on the activities and events at our school. After reviewing our activities and events from the ESD perspective and confirmed it is necessary to develop ESD in our schools.

Objectives of the Project

We understand ESD is 'LINK'. That means we need to understand and help each other with people in this area. The goal is to develop skills to live comfortably.

Because of that we have four activities with a main goal.

①Volunteer

- The teacher tells that there are many chances for the students to be volunteers. The students need to think what a volunteer is.
- The students share what they learn and widen a circle of activity.
- (a) Holiday Volunteer(the student council)...LINK with the local region
- (b) Volunteers for the annual Sports Festival at elementary schools in the area...LINK with the elementary school students
- (c) Volunteer Club...LINK with the region and the help handicapped people.

③International understanding

- We study the life style and culture of each other.
- ④ Others aspects to what is done. Greeting activities with the Community and with local kindergartens.

Execution

1 Volunteer Activity

In our school, the student council does a volunteer activity called "Holiday Volunteer". The student council gathers volunteers and cleans the park of the region in cooperation with the community residents on a holiday. This activity already has the history of 11 years. Now, the connection with the elementary school is achieved, and the schoolchild has also participated. "Holiday Volunteer" is carried out 4 times per year. Every time more than 200 students and more than 50 children participate. They are divided into 12 groups and work in the 12 parks of the region. There is also cooperation of the Healthy Upbringing Society and it is being established as activity with the region. From the last fiscal year, the emergency drill of the region besides cleaning is also carried out. Many junior high school students participate in it.

In addition, there are many events such as Sports Day of elementary school and the region, a festival and so on, that junior high school students can play actively. We value the relation with the schoolchild and the community residents, and work on students who can play actively at any places except the school.

2 Welfare Work

Students have been active in deepening the bonds of a grade and a class through the school events. Moreover, there are also many students who think that "I want to be helpful for the community" through this volunteer activity. Therefore, to let them pay more attention to the society, we let them think about what we can, or what is done to live happily in the "society". After we let students pursue about "the welfare" individually, they experience the welfare work. There are 6 lectures such as "wheelchair", "sign language", "braille", "transliteration", "summary note" and "guide for the blind person". Students choose 2 lectures and experience them. From this experience, there are some students who started to visit the nearby welfare facilities and help the handicapped person voluntarily.

3 Actives for international understanding

There are 60 students who are from Brazil and Pilipino in our school. We conduct personal coaching and team-teaching for them to better understand Japanese. They post documents to introduce their countries to on the wall. Also their guardians actually cook their countries' food and arrange the opportunity for Japanese to taste foreign dishes. Do it like that, we interact with each other.

Foreign students have many chances speak in Japanese to students on a daily basses during class as well as during recesses. They spend school life learning how to use Japanese culture in daily life and understand the different lifestyles between cultures.

Students also work on a volunteering positively. They invite kindergarteners to the school festivals to interact with kindergartens and the students can enjoy entertainment that they have planned for kindergartners.
