Description of the Project

We have worked on the experiences of agriculture and the food educations learning related with local rich natures and industries. Therefore we will promote education (ESD), it can bring up children who are the next generation to make the sustainable society, to educate children who can understand the area and value local various places cooperating with local people.

Especially, at the activity of farm, we have brought up the vegetables of the season at a school farm and ate. Children know the pleasure and the trouble of the crops cultivation with receiving the cooperation and support from farmers or the PTA. Objectives of the Project

Our school will work on the action to ESD with this aim " love Hosoya, and protect natural environments". We want to bring up the children who can say "I love Hosoya" through learning about local nature, industry, culture, and food connecting with local people. And we want children to have the wisdom to coexist with natural environments and become the person who can lead to the sustainable society through getting the sense of values and the acting power in ESD.

Therefore we have aims of three activities.

- (1) Activity to look the area of Hosoya
 - · We stare at the local history (agriculture, fishery, falling of the sericulture business)
 - We stare at local nature (the topography, the shore, bamboo forest, distribution of the forest)

· We study the production of tea which is a local special product .

Through learning such as the local history, the investigation of the traditional industry, and

the observation or the investigation of rich nature, children can be interested in the area and pay more attention to local splendor, trouble and the laborer of ancient people.

(2) Activity to enjoy nature of Hosoya

• We bring up vegetables at a farm and cook it after the crop and eat.

• We bring up rice in the rice field which we borrow from local ones and cook it after the crop and eat.

Children feel the trouble through learning the way of cultivation and the care from farmer. And through cooking food which they harvested, they feel the joy and importance of food.

- (3) Activity to fill flowers a lot in area of Hosoya
 - · We present the flowers which we brought up in whole school for local facilities

We express the feeling of thanks by presenting the flower which brought up ourselves. In addition, children have the wish to want to be beautiful town with a lot of flowers.

Execution

We make the purpose of ESD as follow: ESD is the education that gives the ability to bring the children who become the person leading the sustainable society through children learn deeply about the nature, industry and culture and connection of people which cultivated in that area.

In order to achieve the aim, we will carry the activity connected an event with local learning in Living Environment Studies or the Period of Integrated Study. In addition, we work on the cultivation of farm products and the cultivation of the flower seedling with the whole school. We make the Hosoya ESD learning plan as a practice plan.

Is there any type of evaluation to examine the effects of the project on students' Comprehension and attitudes?

Evaluation of a child's understanding and attitude is done as follows.

- The children's understanding is evaluated as a result of the activities, his/ her report or opinion.
- As a summary of learning, training and activities, open school time, exhibitions, presentations are checked in terms of his/her motivation and attitude.

Along with the assessment above, the following are conducted to enhance ESD activities.

- We carry out a questionnaire to children, their parents and teachers after events by questionnaire or questionnaire about school evaluating to ask the contents as follows. "efficacy of local learning" and "the consciousness change about attachment and pride for local area" In addition, we tell the result to the school councilor and arrange the opportunity to have advice once a year.
- In order to fit the curriculum to the children and the characteristics of the community, the ESD plan is reviewed yearly to improve the situation of kid's learning and training.
